Influenza Vaccinations

Flu season is fast approaching and your best protection from the flu is vaccination. As the vaccine is most effective for 3 months following administration, we recommend you have the vaccine late April through to early June. This will give you maximum protection during the peak influenza period of late winter and early spring.

We will be commencing **influenza vaccination clinics** after Easter. For people who do not qualify for free vaccination the cost will be \$17. See this link: <u>the Australian</u> <u>Government Department of Health</u> to check eligibility for free vaccination.

Please also ensure that you have your winter booster of the **COVID-19 vaccination**. These vaccinations can be administered at the same time.

COVID-19 vaccination remains free for everyone.



Medical Students & GP Registrars

Riverstone Family Medical Practice is committed to training the health professionals of the future. We have **medical students** and **GP Registrars** in our Practice. GP registrars are fully trained doctors who are specialising in general practice. As part of that training our registrars may sit in with another doctor or may have another doctor sitting in with them.

At times you may be asked if another doctor or medical student can be in the consultation with you and your doctor. This decision is entirely up to you and if you do not feel comfortable with another person in the consultation, then please say no to the request. This will not affect your care in any way as your privacy is of utmost importance. If you are comfortable with another doctor or a medical student being present in your consult they will be bound by the same privacy rules as your doctor.
