Free Shingles Vaccination under the National Immunisation Program (NIP)

These vaccinations are available for **eligible people most at risk of complications from shingles**.

A 2-dose course of Shingrix is available for free for:

- People aged 65 years and over
- First Nations people aged 50 years and over
- Some immunocompromised people aged 18 years and over

Shingrix vaccine does not contain the live virus and is safe for people who are immunocompromised.

If you previously received a free Zostavax shingles vaccine under the NIP, you are **not eligible** for a free Shingrix vaccine for at least 5 years.

If you purchased the Zostavax vaccine privately, you can receive Shingrix for free under the program if you're eligible.

You should wait at least 12 months after being immunised with Zostavax or after having shingles and getting the Shingrix vaccine.

Talk to your health professional about your eligibility for the free shingles vaccine today.





Need an appointment today?

- Did you know that if you need an appointment and your doctor is fully booked you can be put on the cancellation list?
- If your doctor has a cancellation then reception will call you to offer you the earlier appointment.
- You cannot get on the cancellation list if you book online so you will need to ring for this.

Medicare Safety Net

If you are seeing a lot of doctors or having a lot of tests with out of pocket costs you may be eligible for **a higher Medicare rebate**. When you spend over a certain amount in a calendar year, Medicare will give you a higher amount back than the usual rebate (up to 80% of your out of pocket costs).

The Safety Net is calculated each calendar year, 1 January to 31 December and couples and families can combine their costs by registering as a family (link to: https://www.servicesaustralia.gov.au/how-to-register-for-medicare-safety-nets?context=22001).
