You are eligible for GP Chronic Condition Management Plan (GPCCMP) if you have one or more chronic medical conditions that have been or are likely to be present for at least six months.

The GPCCMP is a collaborative, written plan prepared by your GP and nurse outlining your health goals, actions needed and other health providers involved in your care. The plan allows for **Medicare-subsidised referrals to Allied Health Services**, promoting coordinated and effective long-term care.

Your Initial Consult: \$90 - Medicare Rebate: \$61.80

Follow-up Consults: \$80 - Medicare Rebate \$61.80

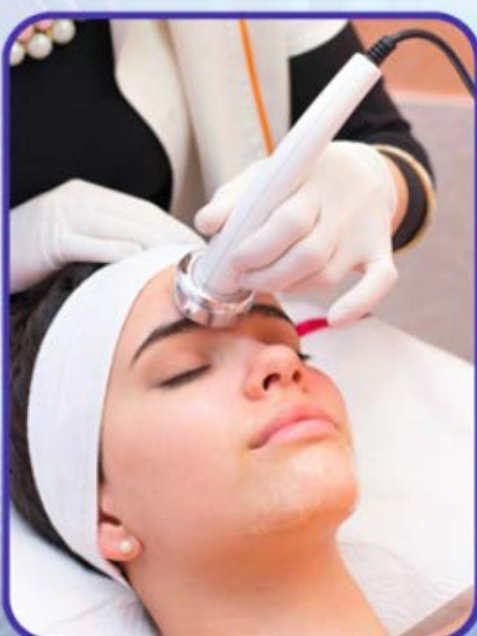

We appreciate your support in helping our team stay focused on delivering excellent care. Thank you for your co-operation and understanding.

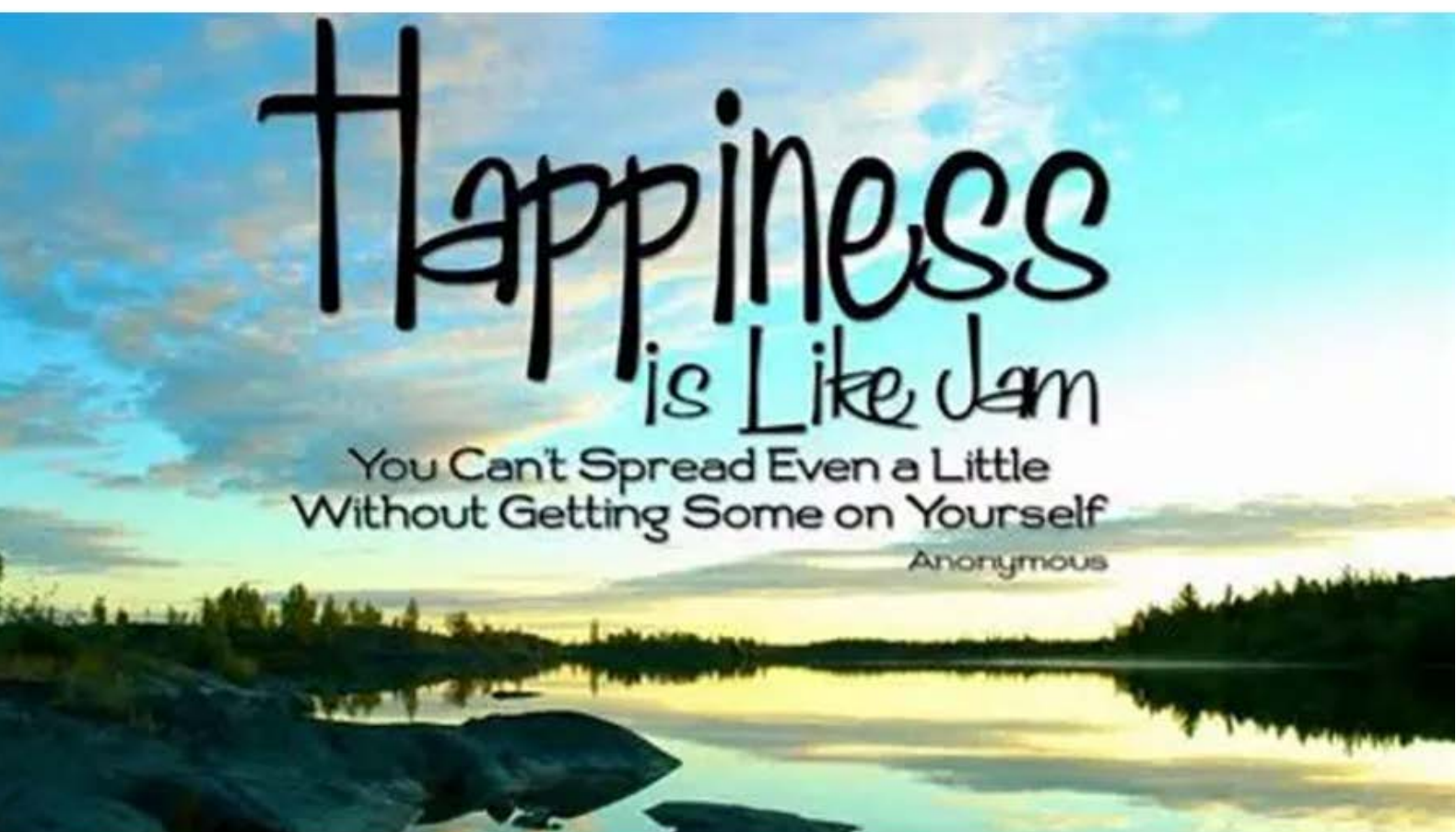
